

Dear member of parliament,

please, allow us to express deep support to the proposal of change of the Constitution in Latvia: *"The state protects and support marriage - a union between a man and a woman, a family based on marriage, kinship or adoption, the rights of parents and children, including the right to grow up in a family based on mother (woman) and father (man). The state provides special assistance to children with disabilities, children left without parental care or victims of violence."*

Our organization by the 420.000 of the signatures of the voters initiated republic referendum about family values in Slovakia. Family values were confirmed by almost 1 million voters. Even referendum was not binding, it had many positive effects to the Slovaks society. Slovakia changed constitution by the similar way, but proposal in your country is better and more specific. Attacks to the meaning of the family (core of the society) became more aggressive in the last years and we need clear positive response.

Let us express our thanks to your support of this change of the Constitution. It is clear, that this is not change of the family values in your country, but confirmation of this values.
